
Need More Signs!

at least 14 signs visible in the foreground













Methods

- Find similar (or exact) sign on Internet
- Modify if needed, ideally using layers to only replace lettering
- Draw if you must
- Don't forget the back (print and attach, or paint)
- Put multiple signs (and copies of same signs) on single sheet
- Print on regular printer paper, photo paper, or cardstock
- Spray with clear varnish to seal and water-repel
- Use NEW x-acto blade to cut out signs
- Darken white edges using sharpie marker or paint pen
- Attach to thicker stock or buildings using glue stick (really)
- Stiff wire and CA for road signs
- Be willing to reprint/replace if not satisfactory

Software tools

- I use GIMP.org, free software
- Others work, but they really must support layers
- Use eyedropper tool to copy exact colors from image
- I use actual inches for dimensions
- Draw zoomed-in, regardless of eventual sign size

Tips

- Use signs to set the era and explain the industry
- All my business names have significance (e.g. Pete's)
- Use proper fonts and colors (National Park Service, USDOT, etc)
- Learn to use "Layers", you'll never regret it.
- Remember you have to cut out the shape, so keep edges simple
- If 2 signs on same pole, overlap them
